This is a unique opportunity to share experiences, learn from other NSOs, and build collaborative networks that transcend borders.

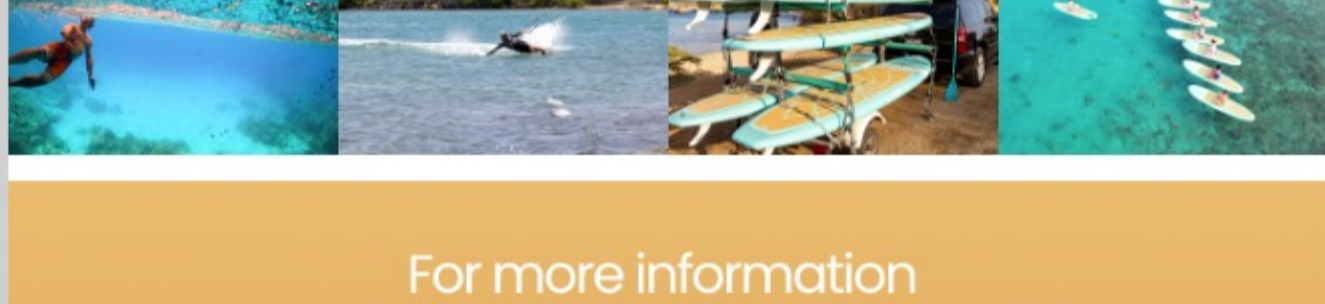
Curaçao
